FOY Group propose to build an **oil refinery** at Hume, Australian Capital Territory and we are **very concerned** about the proximity to **houses, schools, childcare centres and workplaces**.

The refinery would use a **catalytic cracking process** - super heating various plastics to extremely high temperatures - to produce oil in the form of fuels and **fugitive (bad) emissions**.

This will **remove the recyclable plastics** from the circular economy and **negatively impact greenhouse gas emissions** targets, of multiple different Australian states including New South Wales (NSW), Victoria (VIC) and Queensland (QLD), as the source plastics are **transported long distances cross-border** to bypass their more stringent policies.

It is **unsafe** and **was rejected** by **New South Wales Environment Protection Authority**, stating a **lack of environmental and human health safeguards** from this **unproven technology**.

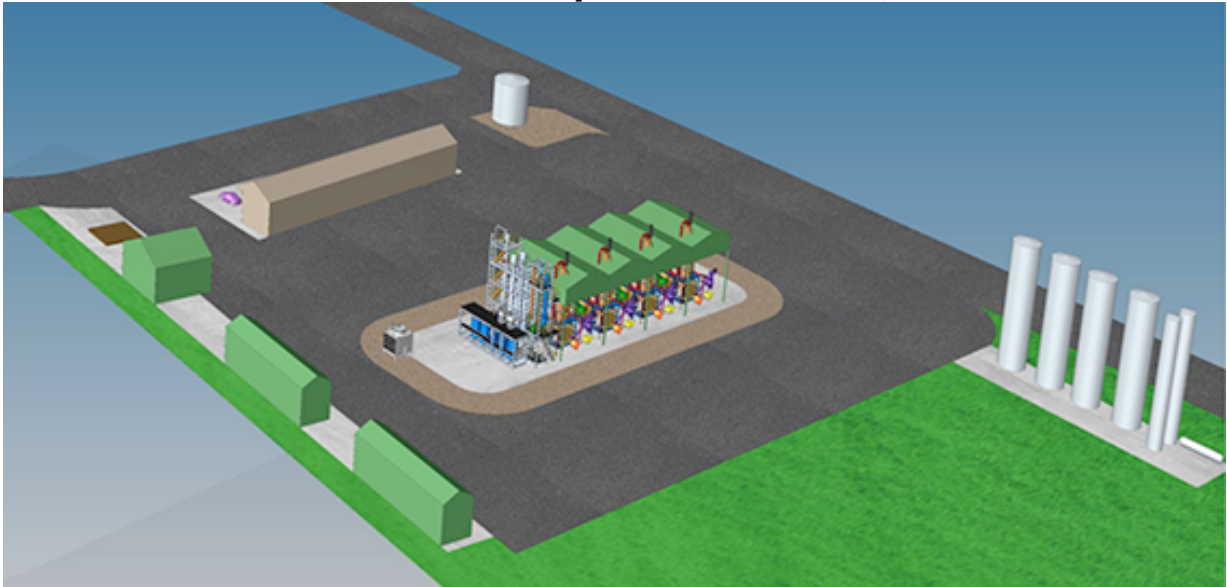
We will **not accept** that this is "recycling" plastics. It is **destructive** (leading to **massive carbon emissions** through the transportation, processing & burning of the fuel products) and **undermines existing and future reuse and recycling**.

You need to **take action, STOP this project** and **protect those that voted you in to your office** to "use the powers of office responsibly and in the interests of the people of the ACT" per your Ministerial Code of Conduct.
